Right Of Way Area Update

In our last community meeting we discussed putting on hold the acquisition of the ROW area (the area where we host food trucks) due to complexity and cost. However, recently, the Department of Roads (who owns that space) notified us that they will not allow us to use it.

We are re-engaging with the Department of Roads and the Township to work through HPHA acquiring the property. Although we don't have all the details on what this will entail, we do know that it will take a great deal of time and a fair amount of funding.

We will keep residents up to date as we move through the process but it likely will not be resolved by the time we schedule food trucks for the season. We are considering alternatives so stay tuned...

UPDATE - Canal Muck Removal

As of 2/3/26, the Township has received enough signatures to move forward with the project, however, the team is continuing to reach out to residents individually. The dredging project is expected to be a topic on the Harrison Township Board of Trustees meeting Monday February 9th to schedule the 2 public hearings. Residents part of the SAD will be notified directly of those dates.

Both phases of project are being planned for this year as previously communicated (see [here](#)) however; specific timing is dependent on bid timing, permitting and contractor availability.
